



Jeremy & Paul Stacey have put together this tribute to the seminal US band Steely Dan. Co-founded by Walter Becker and Donald Fagen in 1972 who, produced a series of iconic albums, including The Royal Scam, Aja and Gaucho.

Tonight, a world-class 14-piece band perform timeless songs from the "Steely Dan" canon. This gig was intended to be a tribute to the band, but since its inception has now also become a tribute to Steely Dan co-founder Walter Becker, who sadly passed away in 2017.

Swansea Jazz Club 75th Anniversary year 2024

Jazz Events began in 1949 under the Swansea Jazz Club name. Jazz continued in the 1950s & 60s as part of Swansea Modern Music Club at the Glamor Club. Swansea Jazz Society formed in 1970s when the club moved to the Liberal Club, before moving to Ellington's in 1990. Swansea Jazzland was formed 1997 and returned to the former Liberal Club, now renamed the St. James Club, in 1997 and continued weekly sessions at the St. James Club until 2018. Moving that year to the Garage Music Venue, before the club moved to it's current venue, Cu Mumbles in 2023
